JUNIPER PASTORAL CARE VOLUNTEERS TRAINING

Juniper has developed a Pastoral Care Volunteers training program and would like to offer the training to interested people and the Churches in Katanning in 2017. The training is targeted to those assisting with Church services and visiting residents one-on-one. It is designed to raise awareness about the significant issues facing residents in aged care facilities, develop skills and communicate important information for those working in a residential aged care environment.

Topics covered include an introduction to Juniper, spirituality, listening and communication, death and dying, grief and loss, dementia, pastoral care role, no lift and infection control. In Perth the training is conducted over six, three hour sessions and in Geraldton five sessions were conducted over a weekend/ The training can be modified in time and content according to local needs and could include other material, for example, talking with family members, or taking a Church service in an aged care setting. 
